"Our purpose is to provide an enjoyable and educational experience while exploring the Biblical perspective of creation and earth history through the use of scientifically sound displays, artifacts and historical data."

The Museum of Earth History (MOEH) is coming to Dallas! This exciting new museum will be a unique representation of the Biblical account of creation using actual research quality dinosaur fossils and authentic scientific artifacts. In addition to the presentation of the Genesis account of creation and Noah's flood, many recent historical and scientific discoveries regarding earth history will be featured that demonstrates the feasibility of Biblical explanation for the earth and life. Each exhibit will reflect the cumulative result of consultation with many recognized scientists in each of their respective disciplines for accuracy of content and conclusions formed in each display. Conventional scientific interpretations of artifacts and data will be examined in the light of the Biblical model.

What sets MOEH-Dallas apart from other creation museums will be the simplistic presentation of its exhibits in light of the genuine findings of science. This museum does not attempt to prove the truth of the Bible scientific, just the feasibility of the Biblical model as a possible explanation for origins. State-of-the-art interactive displays will make the MOEH-Dallas an educational, exciting and entertaining experience.



The Museum of Earth History (Dallas) grew from the joint vision of Dr. G. Thomas Sharp, founder and CEO of The Creation Truth Foundation, Inc., in Noble, Oklahoma and Dennis Lindsey, CEO of Christ For The Nations Institute in Dallas, Texas. Mr. Lindsey and Christ For The Nations Institute have graciously to make available 20,000 square feet in their missions building for the prototype home of the museum. This will allow for 8,500 square feet of exhibit space, as well as a 5,400 square foot "special effects" theater. The building is almost ready for the museum's exhibit construction to begin. Dr. Sharp has contributed many dinosaur fossils and artifacts from the Foundation's large collection and is currently assisting in the acquisition of many other scientific exhibits. We are currently in phase II of completion (this phase consists of the designing of displays, procurement of artifacts, DVD development, budgetary analysis, creation of an internet presence, preparation of promotional and marketing material).



The estimated cost for completion of phase II is \$150,000.00. It is estimated that this phase will take approx. six months to one year to complete. We need people who are willing to invest in the Kingdom to come in on the ground floor of this exciting project. As soon as a revised cost estimate is completed, a fundraising campaign will be launched to satisfy the final costs for completing the project. Phase III will begin with the successful completion of phase II.

Phase III will be the final phase consisting of the actual construction and installation of the displays. There will not be a Bible honoring cultural center of this magnitude anywhere in the Southeastern United States.
